CLASSROOM PROCEDURES and EXPECTATIONS 2018-2019

Daily Class Expectations:

- 1) Come to class on time. Be at your assigned seat when the bell rings. Start work right away!
- 2) Bring materials everyday – charged CHROMEBOOK, spiral notebook, pencil/pen with erasers.
- 3) Be respectful to the teacher, to classmates, and to properties.
- 4) Help maintain an environment that is conducive to learning and is safe to everyone.
- 5) Wait at your assigned seats until the teacher dismisses you.
- 6) Follow district and school policies on PED, absences, tardiness, behavior, and dress code.

Daily Class Routines:

- 1) Take any worksheets before proceeding to your seat.
- 2) Go to the class website (should be bookmarked already) and check the agenda for the day including the objectives and the bell ringer.
- 3) Sharpen pencils before class starts.
- 4) Turn in your paper work in your class mailbox and an electronic copy as directed (Schoology, Google Drive, email among many others).

PED/CHROMEBOOK Policy:

- 1) PEDs (cellphones, iPods, iPads among many others) should be put away the entire period.
- 2) CHROMEBOOKS must be charged when you come to class. You **MUST** have it everyday!
- 3) CHROMEBOOKS are only open when we need to use them. Otherwise, it must be closed.
- 4) CHROMEBOOKS are for instructional purposes only. You must stay in the page you are assigned to work on. Otherwise, it will be a PED violation.
- 5) Be responsible in using your CHROMEBOOK including what you post online. **THINK!!!**

Discipline Plan:

- 1) Verbal warning, detentions, call home, email parent, removal from class, write-up referral, referral to team, referral to principal – in no particular order or combinations, will be given as a consequence.
- 2) All disciplinary issues will be recorded in your PLP (online documentation).

Bathroom and Hallway Passes Policy:

- 1) You will be given four (4) bathroom passes to use every semester.
- 2) Ask permission to use the bathroom pass by waving the pass at the correct time.
- 3) Unused passes can be exchanged for some extra points at the end of the semester.
- 4) Hallway passes can only be given in an emergency situation.
- 5) Passes can only be used 10 minutes before and after the period.

Absences and Make-ups:

- 1) ALL worksheets can be accessed through your Google Drive, our class website, and in class.
- 2) Test and lab make-ups can only be done after school. Please arrange with the teacher.
- 3) It is your responsibility to catch up whatever you missed in class for whatever reason.

Homework (HW)/Assignment/Project Submission Policy:

- 1) Submit HW/assignment online through Schoology during the time frame and date specified by the teacher. Paper submission must be turned in before class on the day it is due.
- 2) NO late class work or HW will be accepted. Arrangement for an extension of an assignment other than a class work or HW should be made to receive credits.

Plagiarism/Cheating Policy:

- 1) Any form of plagiarism and cheating is not tolerated. ALL cases will be given a zero (0) credit. No make up/repeat/alternative work will be given.

Grading Policy:

- 1) It is your first and second semester grades that appear on your permanent transcripts. The following is used to calculate your semester grade:

40% 1st & 3rd Quarter Grade 40% 4th & 2nd Quarter Grade 20% Final Exam Grade

- 2) The quarter grades are determined by the following criteria and weights:
30% Formative Assessments (daily practice; bell ringers; exit slips; labs; binders, etc)
70% Summative Assessments (quizzes; unit tests; project; lab reports; essays; research, etc)

- 3) The following grading scale will be used in this class:

100%-90% = A 89%-80% = B 79%-70% = C 69%-60% = D 59%-0 = F

- 4) You are responsible in checking your grades and missing assignments/tests in Infinite Campus which you can access through our class website or through the mobile app that is available.
- 5) You will be receiving five (5) points weekly for CLASS PARTICIPATION. These points are earned by following our Bulldog PRIDE matrix for proper decorum.
